The [African Union Advisory Board against Corruption](http://www.anticorruption.au.int) is conducting an advocacy mission to the Kingdom of Eswatini from 31st October to 4th November 2022. The purpose of the mission is to lobby for support for ratification of the African Union Convention on Preventing and Combating Corruption (AUCPCC) from different structures in the Kingdom.

The Kingdom of Eswatini signed the Convention on 7th December 2004, but has not acceded and ratified yet.

During the advocacy mission, the Board will meet with the office of the Prime Minister, Minister of Justice, Director of Public Prosecutions, Anti-Corruption Commission, Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation, Ministry of Home Affairs, The Parliament, Civil Society and Media, among other entities.

The African Union Advisory Board against Corruption welcomes the cooperation and commitment of the Kingdom of Eswatini and looks forward to continued collaboration with the government and people of Eswatini in the fight against corruption.

Notes for Editors:

The African Union Convention on Preventing and Combating Corruption was adopted on 11th July 2003 at the 2nd Ordinary Session of the Assembly.
